



Aztec completes office revamp at Murray House

Fit out firm Aztec has completed a refurbishment of a two-storey office occupied by further education consultancy IEC Abroad, located in Murray House at 85-87 Piccadilly, Manchester city centre.

The office, which totals 12,000 sq ft in total across the first and second floors, is being used as IEC Abroad's head office to educate and train international students who want to gain access into first class higher educational institutions.



Aztec, which has offices in Liverpool and Manchester, completed the contract within four weeks.
