**THE search is on to find the UK's most fantastic families – and organisers want to hear from people in Renfrewshire who reckon they fit the bill.**

The winners of the Candis Outstanding Family of the Year Awards will share a range of top prizes, including a four-star luxury holiday and cash awards worth over £500.

A spokesman for the competition's organisers said: "Do you know a remarkable family that have worked together to achieve something amazing?"

"Perhaps they've worked tirelessly to clean up their neighbourhood, campaigned to change legislation, taken a stand against injustice or sacrificed their free time to help others? Maybe they've worked hard for the benefit of their local community, for society in general or for a charity or cause close to their hearts?"

"Candis is looking to celebrate the achievements of families from all over Britain with its Outstanding Family of the Year Awards and nominations are now open."

There are five different categories to enter – The Fundraisers, for families who've worked together to raise money for a good cause; The Carers, for the family who foster, adopt or otherwise devote their time to caring for children or adults with additional needs; The Campaigners, for the family who have worked hard to change opinions, educate others, improve conditions or quality of life at home or abroad; The Health Heroes, for the family who've greatly improved their own lives and the lives of others through promoting healthy activity; and The Community Champions, for families who have made a real difference to their neighbourhood.

There is no age limit and any family dynamic is welcome, although organisers do ask for the involvement of more than one generation of each family.
