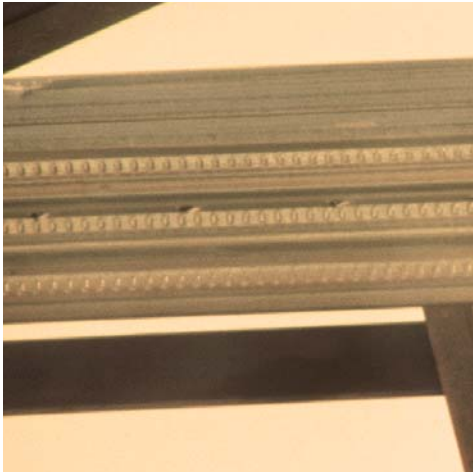

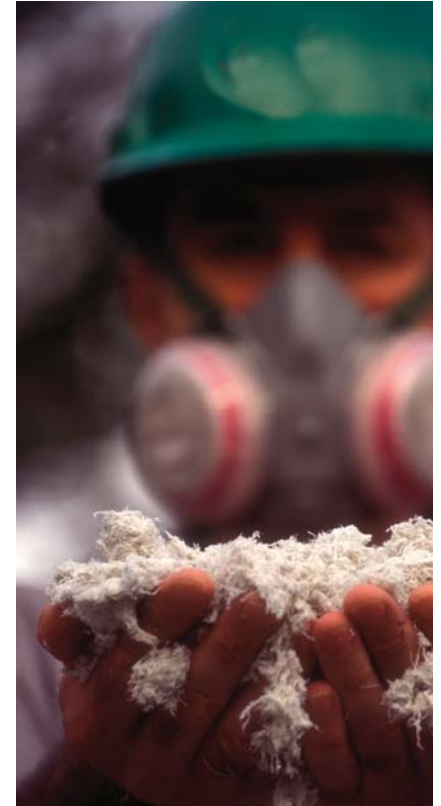

WHEN SHOULD YOU CLAIM?

Claims must be brought within three years of your "date of knowledge". This may not be from the date of your diagnosis but from knowledge of the symptoms. This is why it is important that you discuss the details of your claim with us as soon as possible.

WHAT IF THE COMPANY NO LONGER EXISTS?

Compensation is paid to you by the defendant's insurance company. If the company you worked for no longer exists, their insurers can still be held to account. We have considerable success in tracing insurers in cases where a company ceased to operate some time ago.

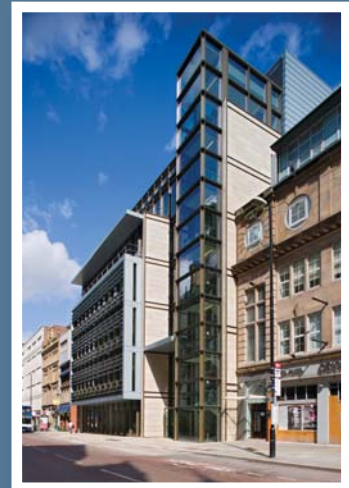
