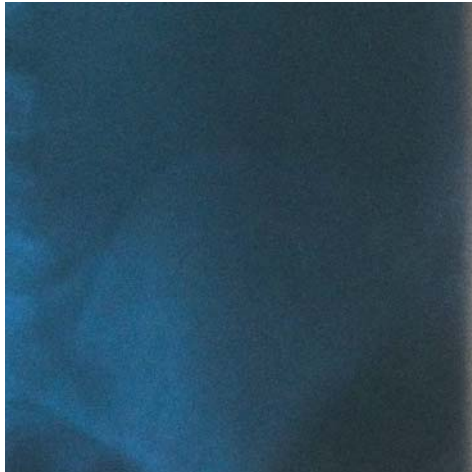
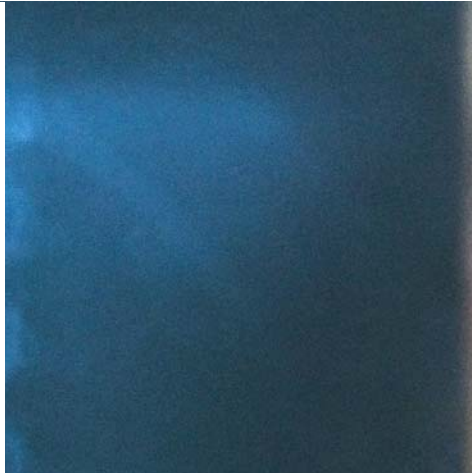
Head and brain injuries

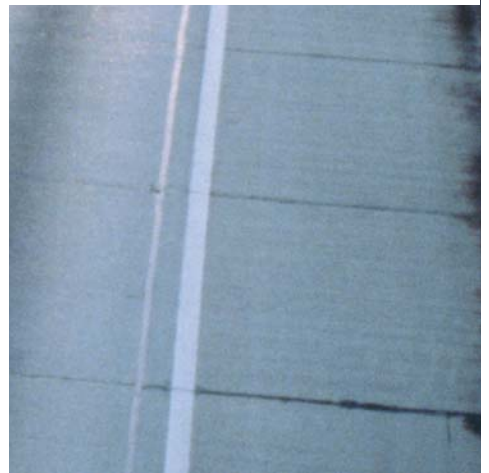

Accidents at work

The Health and Safety Executive estimates that individual employees lose around five hundred and fifty eight million pounds a year in reduced income and additional expenditure as a result of accidents at work.

In addition victims and their families suffer further in the form of pain, grief and loss of amenity. 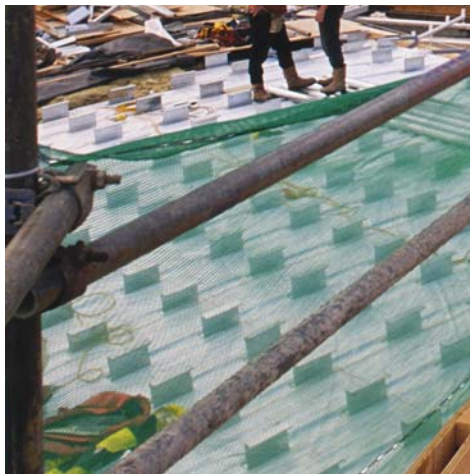

Industrial disease

Diseases attributable to conditions of employment include asbestos related diseases, other respiratory diseases, vibration white finger, skin diseases, industrial deafness and tinnitus. The Health and Safety Executive estimates that approximately three thousand workers will die each year as a result of exposure to asbestos products.

Very often industrial disease results from exposure to a substance or an unsafe working practice over a period of many years. Claims often involve the detailed investigation of an individual's working history.

Many claimants are unaware that their health problems relate to their occupation. By way of example those who have worked with vibrating tools may suffer numbness, pins and needles, and reduced dexterity of the fingers and hands without understanding the connection with their occupation.
