

## PACT ENVIRONMENTAL VISUAL AUDIT

### **PACT**

PACT stands for Partners and Communities Together. It gives you the chance to tell your local policing team, local authority and other partner agencies about the issues causing most concern in your neighbourhood and which ones you want dealt with as a priority. Once the community agrees on the priorities, we'll work together to address them.

The delivery of PACT is tailored to meet the needs of the community, but can include public meetings and events, postcards and local surgeries.

### **About This Form**

Environmental Visual Audits (EVA) form part of the PACT process. They allow groups or individuals to provide detailed feedback to their local policing team on a number of concerns or issues.

EVA forms can be completed by individuals or groups (a Neighbourhood Watch, for example) and may be accompanied by photos to provide further information or detail.

The form below can be printed off, completed and returned by post to your local Policing team. Alternatively, save the form, complete it electronically and return it as an e-mail attachment to your local policing team. Please also attach any photographs that have been taken to support your audit.
