

## DEFEND YOUR DEFENDER

Police are warning the owners of Land Rover Defenders to review their security following incidents involving these vehicles in Worcestershire in recent weeks.

At least one Defender has been stolen and another had parts removed from it while parked. It is believed that stolen vehicles are stripped down and components sold on the spares market.

In the light of these incidents owners are urged to be extra vigilant and ensure their vehicles are secure. We would strongly recommend the following:

- Lock all windows and doors and activate immobilisers if fitted



- Use a steering lock or other security device
- Park in a garage or out of sight of the road if possible
- Remove all personal property from the vehicle when unattended

Our patrols are paying special attention to Land Rover Defenders in the area but you can help by reporting any suspicious activity around your vehicle to the police immediately. This might include people hanging around or driving past slowly. If you have such concerns please make a note of the registration of any vehicles involved.
